- Keep parents informed about school activities through regular communication home.
- Be open and welcoming and offer opportunities for parents to become involved in the daily life of the academy.

## **I / We shall:**

- Treat everyone in the academy with respect.
- Make sure my child attends the academy in the academy uniform.
- Make sure my child arrives at the academy punctually.
- Make sure my child attends the academy regularly, bringing any belongings necessary for lessons, and provide an explanation if my child is absent and not to take holidays in term time without the agreement of the Principal.
