Dear Parents and Carers,

This week marked the beginning of our Scoot to School initiative. Years 3, 4 and 5 undertook a variety of activities aimed at encouraging our children to scoot responsibly and safely. We hope that this training will give them the skills to allow them to scoot to and from the academy safely in the future. Although the aim of the sessions focussed on safety skills the children also had lots of fun at the same time. We have put some of the photos on the website for you to look at.

Years 1, 2 and 6 will be able to take their turn on Tuesday 8th October. If your child is in one of these year groups you should have received a permission slip which needs to be returned to us prior to this date. Your child will need a scooter and a helmet – if your child does not have one please ask one of their friends as long as they are not in the same class.

As part of this project we received a grant to buy some dedicated scooter storage. This scooter pod has been fixed on to the wall at the front of the academy near the office/staffroom. Please make use of these as well as the cycle shed. Although only one scooter can be stored in each slot in the pod, it is possible to secure more than one scooter to the railings in the cycle shed. The scooters should be locked as shown in the pictures as shown below. Please note we cannot be responsible for bikes and scooters left on site so we strongly recommend items are locked with a cycle lock from home.
