## Car Park Gate - Changes to Car Park Access

Over the Easter holidays, we will be having a new electric gate installed at the car park entrance.

This will allow us to close the access to the car park and school site, improving school security, as visitors will have to request permission to come on the site.

There will also be a controlled gate access for pedestrians.

The car park will be open at drop off and pick up times, but it does mean that the car park will not be open for pick up at the end of the day until 3pm.

## Water Bottles

In school children are encouraged to bring a water bottle, as hydration is important to health and concentration. In school, water bottles are held in a central place and children can drink when they need to. There are specific times where a child could have their water bottle on their desk e.g. hospital advice is to drink a considerable amount in the day for health testing or infections. This should be discussed with your class teacher, so that they can support children in school.
